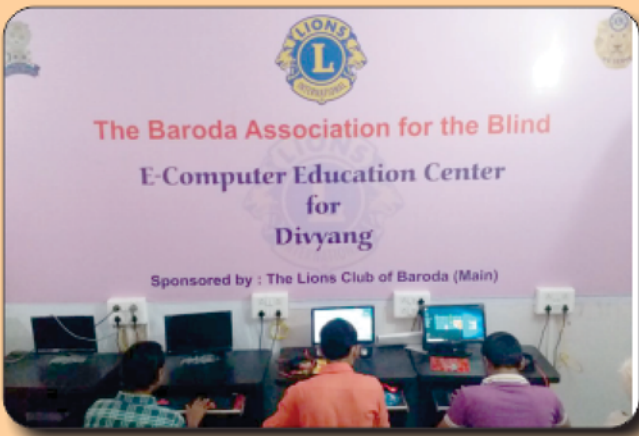

## **ENGINEERS PROSPECTS INDIAN ECONOMY POINT OF VIEW**



USA produces around 1 lakh Engineers per year for a \$ 16 Trillion Economy.

India produces 15 lakhs Engineers for a \$ 2 Trillion Economy.

Analysing at the above scenario, there seems to be an adequate demand to pull them in. This however, is far from the truth. Past data points that the earlier mass recruiting sector was manufacturing, with major recruitments being from the core branches like Civil, Electrical and Mechanical. As the years progressed, this sector has been stagnant, at just 17% of the GDP. Hence, there is a dearth of placements of these core branches.

An emerging recruiter is the IT sector, growing from scratch to almost 5% of the GDP in a little less than 25 years, employing close to a million people across the length and breadth of the country. With demand also comes supply. Over the past 5 years or so, the IT sector is gradually becoming immensely saturated. Only the highly talented are being picked up.

If you go through the sectoral composition of the Indian economy, most of these sectors do not need engineers. For instance, the Tourism sector, which accounts for more than 10% of the GDP, does not require engineers. Neither do the Financial, Trade, Hotels & Restaurants. Requirement in Health, Education & Agriculture is almost negligible.

The above data prove that more than 50% of the GDP has no role for engineers. With the advent of engineering colleges in the country and admission rates in these colleges, there has never been a higher supply of fresh engineers than today. The current situation is not sustainable. The demand is less whereas the supply is high. Today the situation is that most engineers are working in a field that has no connection to what they have studied in the college.

We need to replan the whole education system. Cut down on the number of colleges and improve the quality in the rest.

Students should explore career options thoroughly before taking a call for Future Prospects.

*The theme for World Environment Day 2018, is a call to action for all of us to come together to combat one of the great environmental challenges of our time. Chosen by this year's host, India, the theme of World Environment Day 2018 invites us all to consider how we can make changes in our everyday lives to reduce the heavy burden of plastic pollution on our natural places, our wildlife – and our own health.*

*While plastic has many valuable uses, we have become over reliant on single-use or disposable plastic – with severe environmental consequences. Around the world, 1 million plastic drinking bottles are purchased every minute. 500 billion disposable plastic bags are used worldwide every year. In total, 50 per cent of the plastic we use is single use.*

*Nearly one third of the plastic packaging we use escapes collection systems, which means that it ends up clogging our city streets and polluting our natural environment. Every year, up to 13 million tons of plastic leak into our oceans, where it smothers coral reefs and threatens vulnerable marine wildlife. The plastic that ends up in the oceans can circle the Earth four times in a single year, and it can persist for up to 1,000 years before it fully disintegrates.*

*Plastic also makes its way into our water supply – and thus into our bodies. What harm does that cause? Scientists still aren't sure, but plastics contain a number of chemicals, many of which are toxic or disrupt hormones. Plastics can also serve as a magnet for other pollutants, including dioxins, metals and pesticides.*

### **If you can't reuse it, refuse it**

*This year's World Environment Day provides an opportunity for each of us to embrace the many ways that we can help to combat plastic pollution around the world. And you don't have to wait until 5 June to act.*

## HPV Vaccine



*HPV vaccine is important because it protects against cancers caused by human papillomavirus (HPV) infection. HPV is most common in people in their late teens and early 20s. Almost all people will get HPV at some time in their lives, though most will never even know it. Most of the time, the body naturally fights off HPV, before HPV causes any health problems. But in some cases, the body does not fight off HPV, and HPV can cause health problems, like cancer and genital warts. Genital warts are not a life-threatening disease, but they can cause emotional stress, and their treatment can be very uncomfortable.*

*Most people with HPV never develop symptoms or health problems. Most HPV infections (9 out of 10) go away by themselves within two years. But, sometimes, HPV infections will last longer, and can cause certain cancers and other diseases. HPV infection can cause:*

- *cancers of the cervix, vagina, and vulva in women;*
- *cancers of the penis in men; and*
- *cancers of the anus and back of the throat, including the base of the tongue and tonsils (oropharynx), in both women and men.*

Cervical cancer is ranked as the most frequent cancer in women in India.

Vaccination can be given to females as young as 9 years as well as in those aged 13–26 years who have not previously completed vaccination. Pap testing and screening for HPV DNA or HPV antibody before vaccination is not needed. Routine cervical cancer screening should be continued.

### Types of vaccines

1. Bivalent **Cervarix**
2. Quadrivalent **Gardasil**

License to use in India, Females between 9 - 45 years

Preferred target age group, Females between 9 - 14 years

### Take Home Message

HPV vaccination is for primary prevention of carcinoma cervix. There is no risk of getting an HPV infection from the vaccine as the vaccine does not contain live virus. HPV vaccination and regular cervical screening is the most effective way to prevent cervical cancer. **All females between the ages of 13 to 26 should be vaccinated.**
